A quorum was not present. Deborah Lagos chaired the meeting.

Review and Approval of Meeting Minutes for the October 3rd and December 5th, 2023 and March 5th, 2024 Ad Hoc Committee Meetings

Deborah Lagos asked if there were any comments or corrections to the minutes. None were mentioned. A quorum was not present so the minutes could not be approved. They will be placed on the agenda for the next meeting.

Discussion of NIP Implementation Plan

Deborah Lagos and Steve Vecchi presented an update on the status of the Noise Insulation Program.

The tasks that have been completed to date for NIP Group 1 were reviewed, starting with the bid opening through the FAA grant application. Two bids were received. There is a \$1.5 million construction budget which will allow construction of ten (10) homes.

The NIP Group 1 Pre-Construction Tasks were described, followed by the Construction Tasks. The NTP-Permits should be issued on October 1, 2024, and the NTP-Construction should be issued on January 25, 2025. The total construction time is 235 calendar days, of which 119 days are for pre-construction and 116 days are

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for construction. Ultimately, the number of days needed for construction will depend on the number of houses that will be constructed.

The results of the Assessment of Grace Lutheran Church & School were presented. Five (5) buildings were evaluated including four (4) school buildings and the church. A description of the construction of each building was presented, including the air conditioning and ventilation, and window and door types.

The status of the acoustical testing for eligibility was presented and included 122 rooms in 22 single- and multi-family residences. Additional properties will be tested in July. Based on houses tested to-date, none of the houses in the block rounding area (Properties 44-63) are eligible, and all but one of Properties 18-43 and 64 are eligible.

Proposed 2024 Schedule

The proposed schedule was reviewed, but since a quorum was not present the schedule could not be approved.
